Psalm 13 - A Prayer for the LORD's Help

- ¹ How much longer, LORD, will you forget about me? Will it be forever?

 How long will you hide?
- ²How long must I be confused and miserable all day?
 How long will my enemies keep beating me down?
- ³ Please listen, LORD God, and answer my prayers.
 Make my eyes sparkle again, or else I will fall into the sleep of death.
- ⁴ My enemies will say,
 "Now we've won!"
 They will be greatly pleased when I am defeated.
- ⁵ I trust your love,
 and I feel like celebrating
 because you rescued me.
 ⁶ You have been good to me, LORD,
 and I will sing about you.

Psalm 51-A Prayer for Forgiveness

- ¹ You are kind, God! Please have pity on me. You are always merciful! Please wipe away my sins.
- ² Wash me clean from all of my sin and guilt.
- ³ I know about my sins, and I cannot forget my terrible guilt.
- ⁴ You are really the one I have sinned against; I have disobeyed you and have done wrong.

So it is right and fair for you to correct and punish me.

- ⁵ I have sinned and done wrong since the day I was born.
- ⁶ But you want complete honesty, so teach me true wisdom.
- ⁷ Wash me with hyssop until I am clean and whiter than snow.
- ⁸ Let me be happy and joyful! You crushed my bones, now let them celebrate.
- ⁹ Turn your eyes from my sin and cover my guilt.
- ¹⁰ Create pure thoughts in me and make me faithful again.
- ¹¹ Don't chase me away from you or take your Holy Spirit away from me.
- ¹² Make me as happy as you did when you saved me; make me want to obey!
- ¹³ I will teach sinners your Law, and they will return to you.
- ¹⁴ Keep me from any deadly sin. Only you can save me! Then I will shout and sing about your power to save.
- ¹⁵ Help me to speak, and I will praise you, Lord.
- Offerings and sacrifices are not what you want.
- ¹⁷ The way to please you is to feel sorrow deep in our hearts.
- This is the kind of sacrifice you won't refuse.
- ¹⁸ Please be willing, Lord, to help the city of Zion and to rebuild its walls.

Psalm 22 - Suffering and Praise

(This is what Christ began to pray on the cross.)

¹My God, my God, why have you deserted me?
Why are you so far away?
Won't you listen to my groans and come to my rescue?
² I cry out day and night, but you don't answer, and I can never rest.

³ Yet you are the holy God, ruling from your throne and praised by Israel.
⁴ Our ancestors trusted you, and you rescued them.
⁵ When they cried out for help, you saved them,
and you did not let them down when they depended on you.

⁶ But I am merely a worm, far less than human, and I am hated and rejected by people everywhere.
⁷ Everyone who sees me makes fun and sneers.
They shake their heads,

- ⁹ You, LORD, brought me safely through birth, and you protected me when I was a baby at my mother's breast.

- ¹¹ Don't stay far off when I am in trouble with no one to help me.
- Enemies are all around like a herd of wild bulls.Powerful bulls from Bashan are everywhere.
- ¹³ My enemies are like lions roaring and attacking with jaws open wide.
- ¹⁴ I have no more strength than a few drops of water.All my bones are out of joint; my heart is like melted wax.
- ¹⁵ My strength has dried up like a broken clay pot, and my tongue sticks to the roof of my mouth.
- You, God, have left me to die in the dirt.
- ¹⁶ Brutal enemies attack me like a pack of dogs, tearing at my hands and my feet.
- ¹⁷ I can count all my bones, and my enemies just stare and sneer at me.
- ¹⁸ They took my clothes and gambled for them.
- ¹⁹ Don't stay far away, LORD! My strength comes from you, so hurry and help.
- ²⁰ Rescue me from enemy swords and save me from those dogs.
- Don't let lions eat me.

You rescued me from the horns of wild bulls,

- and when your people meet, I will praise you, LORD.
- All who worship the LORD, now praise him!
 You belong to Jacob's family and to the people of Israel, so fear and honor the LORD!
 The LORD doesn't hate or despise the helpless in all of their troubles.

- When your people meet, you will fill my heart with your praises, LORD, and everyone will see me keep my promises to you.
